Biography of Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke

Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke was born in Richland Center, Wisconsin, ordained to the holy priesthood by Pope Saint Paul VI at St. Peter's Basilica on June 29, 1975, obtained a Doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Gregorian University in 1984, appointed Defender of the Bond at the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura in Rome in 1989, appointed Bishop of La Crosse by Pope Saint John Paul II in 1994 and named Archbishop of Saint Louis in 2003, appointed the Prefect of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura by Pope Benedict XVI in 2008, and elevated to the College of Cardinals in 2010. In 2000, he founded the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse, Wisconsin, and dedicated the Shrine Church in 2008.
