### **Biography of Bishop Erik T. Pohlmeier**

Bishop Erik Thomas Pohlmeier, born July 20, 1971, became the 11th bishop of the Diocese of St.

Augustine, Florida, after his appointment by Pope Francis on May 24, 2022. He was ordained and installed on July 22, 2022, succeeding Bishop Felipe J. Estévez. His episcopal motto is "Seek first the kingdom of God."

Ordained a priest on July 25, 1998, at Subiaco Abbey in Arkansas, Bishop Pohlmeier served in the Diocese of Little Rock in various pastoral roles. He ministered at several parishes, including Christ the King in Little Rock, St. John the Baptist in Hot Springs, and Our Lady of the Holy Souls in Little Rock. He also held key diocesan positions, such as director of permanent diaconate formation and director of faith formation.

Pope Francis appointed him as bishop on May 24, 2022. Now leading 174,000 Catholics across 17 counties in North Florida, Bishop Pohlmeier focuses on evangelization, strengthening the faith, and engaging the community throughout the Diocese of St. Augustine, Florida.
