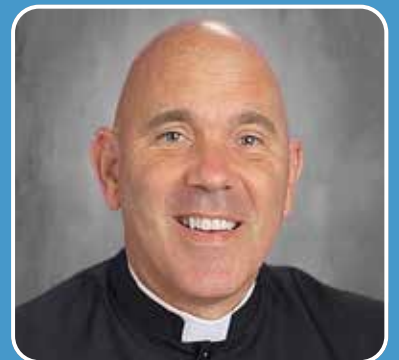

Reverend Rafael Lavilla

Father Rafael Lavilla was born in September 1976 in Pasig City, Metro Manila, Philippines. At just 14 years old, the same year he was accepted to the Sisters of Mary School, he made the difficult decision to instead enter the Oblates of St. Joseph Minor Seminary, beginning his 15-year priestly formation.

He was ordained a priest on November 25, 2005, served as a missionary in California beginning in 2008, and moved to Jacksonville, Florida, in 2013 to join the Diocese of St. Augustine, where he was incardinated in 2019. Father Lavilla is currently the Pastor of St. John Paul II Catholic Church in Nocatee, Ponte Vedra, Florida.

Reverend David Keegan

Father David Keegan was born in New Iberia, Louisiana, and is the fifth of six children. He spent his formative years outside Birmingham, Alabama, before moving to Northeast Florida as a young adult. After years of living a secular life, he encountered the mercy of Jesus in a life-changing way during a retreat in the fall of 2006. Sensing a call to the priesthood, he entered seminary in 2009 and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of St. Augustine in 2016. Since 2018, he has joyfully served as pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jacksonville, Florida.
