Bishop Frank J. Caggiano

Bishop Frank J. Caggiano has served as the fifth Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Bridgeport, Connecticut, since his installation in 2013. Born in Brooklyn, New York, to Italian immigrant parents, he discerned his vocation after beginning studies at Yale University and went on to earn advanced degrees in philosophy and theology, including a doctorate from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome.

Ordained a priest for the Diocese of Brooklyn in 1987, he later served as Auxiliary Bishop of Brooklyn before being appointed Bishop of Bridgeport by Pope Francis. As bishop, he has led significant diocesan renewal efforts, including the first diocesan synod in over thirty years, with a strong focus on evangelization, youth engagement, and pastoral leadership within the Church.

Chris McMahon is the CEO of MFA Wealth and Aquinas Wealth Advisors in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, with more than 30 years of experience in faith-based financial planning. He is honored to serve on the board of the Sisters of Mary World Villages for Children, reflecting his deep commitment to Catholic charity and service.
