Reverend David Keegan

Father David Keegan was born in New Iberia, Louisiana, and is one of six children. After a life-changing encounter with Christ in 2006, he discerned a call to the priesthood and entered seminary in 2009. He was ordained for the Diocese of St. Augustine in 2016 and has served as pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jacksonville, Florida, since 2018.

Reverend Kurian Kollapallil

Father Kurian Kollapallil, born in Kerala, India in 1969, is a member of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales and was ordained in 1997. He served in missions across Tanzania and Kenya, where he founded a foster home and school for street children, and later ministered in the Diocese of Lansing, Michigan. Since October 2023, he has served at Our Lady Star of the Sea in Ponte Vedra Beach.

Reverend Rafael Lavilla

Father Rafael Lavilla was born in 1976 in Pasig City, Philippines. He entered seminary formation at age 14 and was ordained a priest in 2005. After serving as a missionary in California, he moved to Florida in 2013 and was incardinated into the Diocese of St. Augustine in 2019. He currently serves as pastor of St. John Paul II Catholic Church in Nocatee, FL.

Reverend Monsignor Joseph Schaedel

Ordained for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis in 1982 after a career as a Catholic educator and principal, Rev. Monsignor Joseph F. Schaedel previously served in key leadership roles, including Vicar General and pastor of Saint Luke Parish. He currently serves as a chaplain, adjunct professor, and active board member across several educational and healthcare organizations.
